

TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TAP)

Air National Guard members serving in accordance with **Title 32**, U.S.C. who achieve retirement or separation eligibility **without serving 180 days or more of continuous active duty** (Title 10, U.S.C.) may voluntarily attend TAP but are not required. TAP services may be made available to members as resources and capacity allow and are subject to the discretion of the responsible commander at the nearest active-duty installation. Service member may avail themselves of the “virtual” curriculum at any time.
