COLONEL JOHN R. O'CONNOR

Colonel John R. O'Connor is the Commander, 174th Attack Wing, Hancock Field, Syracuse, NY. He is responsible for the command and control of MQ-9 combat operations supporting combatant commanders in multiple theaters of operation. Additionally, the Wing performs MQ-9 Test, Formal Training Unit, Maintenance Field Training Detachment, Maintenance, Mission Support and Medical Group functions, as well as hosting the 152nd Air Operations Group providing multi-domain command and control capability to USAFE-AFAFRICA. The 174th Attack Wing regularly answers deployment requirements around the globe and provides immediate domestic response capability as directed by the Governor of New York.

Colonel O'Connor graduated from the State University of New York College at Plattsburgh in 1988. He was commissioned through the United States Air Force Officer Training School at Lackland AFB, Texas in 1989 and earned his Master of Science Degree in Human Resource Management from Troy University, Alabama in 1991. Colonel O'Connor served on active duty for nine years holding leadership positions in supply operations, logistics management and as an Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies in the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps. He joined the New York Air National Guard in 1998 and



held squadron and group command positions in both the Maintenance and Mission Support Groups. Additionally, the Colonel served as the Principal Deputy Director of Logistics, Engineering and Force Protection at the National Guard Bureau Air National Guard Readiness Center. Colonel O'Connor deployed in support of combat operations in Operation DESERT STORM/SOUTHERN WATCH and Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. Prior to his current assignment, Col O'Connor served as the Vice Commander, 107th Attack Wing, Niagara Falls, NY.
