CMSgt Sonja Antoinette Williams, Command Chief for the 174th Attack Wing, Syracuse, NY. As the Senior Enlisted Leader, CMSgt Williams the commander's key enlisted advocate and advisor on operational effectiveness and the organization, training and equipping of enlisted Airmen. Her job is to ensure the commanders' directions and policies are carried out and the Airmen understand and are dedicated to the mission of the command. She is responsible for the professional development and proper utilization of the command's enlisted force and works with other enlisted leaders such as group SELs and first sergeants to oversee the readiness, training, health, morale, welfare, quality of life and force development of assigned personnel.

CMSgt Williams enlisted in the New York Air National Guard in December 1997 as a Personnel Specialist. She attended technical school at Keesler AFB, MS. Upon her return to the 174th Fighter Wing, she was assigned to the Commander Support Staff in the Logistics Readiness Squadron. In August 2006 she cross-trained into the Education and Training career field and transferred to the 174th Civil Engineer Squadron where she became the Unit Education and Training Manager (UTEM). In this position, she was instrumental in the squadron's transformation of training records from paper based to electronic. In May of 2011, while assigned to the Civil Engineer Squadron, CMSgt Williams deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom to the Manas Transit Center located near Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. In May 2012, Chief Master Sergeant Williams was selected as the Wing Human Resources Advisor (HRA) and received national recognition for her accomplishments. In 2018 she was selected to be the Mission Support Group SEL but left in 2019 to fill a one-year position as the 174th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron SEL. In 2020 she returned to the Mission Support Group as the SEL.



CMSgt Williams is also a High School Spanish Teacher. She has held this position for 20 years. Chief Williams is also the past President of her local branch of The American Association for University Women. A position that she has held for two years. She is a member of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States, the Non-commissioned Officer Association and the Air Force Sergeants Association. Chief Williams is also a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.
