Operates cyberspace weapons systems and commands crews to accomplish cyberspace, training, and other missions.

## **QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS**

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender or national origin.
- Applications are subject to review by the MPF and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB).
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in AFI 36-2005.

**KNOWLEDGE:** Knowledge is mandatory including electronics theory, information technology, telecommunications and supervisory and control systems including cryptography, vulnerability assessment and exploitation techniques. Additionally knowledge will include operational planning, governing cyberspace operations directives, procedures and tactics.

**EXPERIENCE:** For upgrade to AFSCs 17S2X/3X, unit commander determines proficiency based on performance, experience and completion of minimum training requirements

## DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position is part of the 9<sup>th</sup> Air Force Joint Task Force and will be expected to deploy every three years for six month. Additional TDYs may be required for training and exercise.

Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking and intelligence information. Supervises mission planning, preparation and crew briefing/debriefing. Ensures equipment and crew are mission ready prior to execution/deployment.

Operates weapons system(s) and commands crew. Performs, supervises, or directs weapons system employment and associated crew activities.

Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.

Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

**OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicant must be less than age 40 at the time of commissioning. Must satisfactorily complete the AF Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT) prior to selection board and (after selection) pass a Commissioning Physical. Applicant is encouraged to contact SMSgt Bradley Addison @ (315) 233-2147 ASAP to be scheduled for the test. The results must be available prior to scheduling the OSIB. (Applicant may apply for position prior to test taking). When selectee is approved for appointment by NGB, attendance of six weeks at Total Force Officer Training (TFOT) is Mandatory.

**OSIB:** An officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB) is projected to convene TBA to interview and/all qualified applicants.
