QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS

Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender or national origin. Applications are subject to review by the FSS and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB). The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in AFI 36-2005.

KNOWLEDGE: Knowledge is mandatory of theory of flight, air navigation, meteorology, flying directives, aircraft operating procedures, and mission tactics.

EDUCATION: For entry into this specialty, undergraduate degree specializing in physical sciences, mathematics, administration, or management is desirable.

EXPERIENCE: For upgrade to AFSCs 11M2X/3X, unit commander determines proficiency based on performance, experience, and completion of minimum training requirements.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Conducts or supervises training of JTF Members. Ensures operational readiness by conducting or supervising mission specific training. crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training. Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.
Open to any Rated 11, 12, 13 Rated Officer – this is a non-flying position.
Position is part of 9th Air Force Joint Task Force and will be expected to deploy every three years for six months.
TDYs may be required for training and exercise support.
